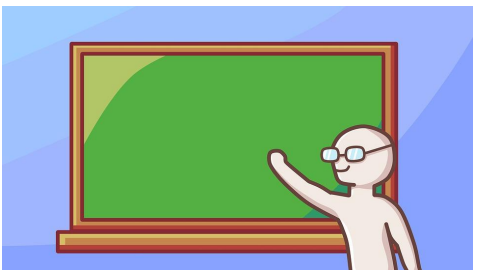

We thought about all the different types of transport that we could use to get to our holiday destination including trains, cars and planes.

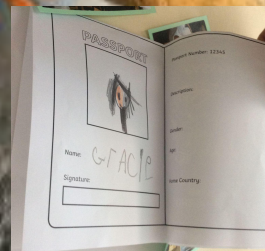
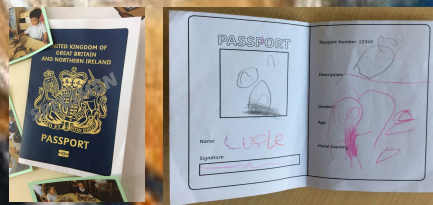


# Big Wide World

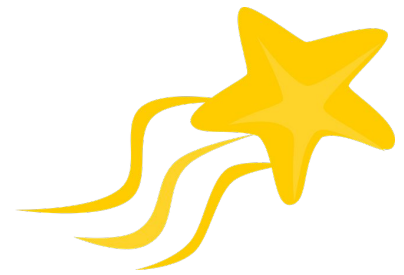
## Reporting a child's absence
