Foundation 1

- Autumn 1 Nursery Rhyme Focus
- Autumn 2 Phase 1, Aspects 1-3 (Environmental Sounds, Instrumental Sounds, Body Percussion)
- Spring 1 Review Phase 1, Aspects 1-3, add in Aspects 4-5 (Rhythm and Rhyme, Alliteration)
- Spring 2 Review Phase 1, Aspects 1-5
- Summer 1 Review Phase 1, Aspects 1-5, add in Aspects 6-7 (Voice Sounds, Oral Segmenting)
- Summer 2 Review Phase 1, Aspects 1-7 with a greater focus on Oral Segmenting. Introduce some early Phase 2 letter sounds if children are ready.
