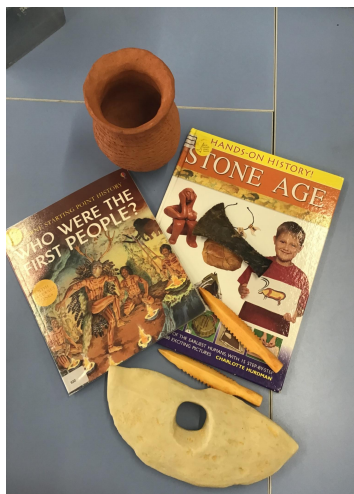

Year 3 have been using artefacts, books, video clips and images to find out how life in the Stone Age developed.

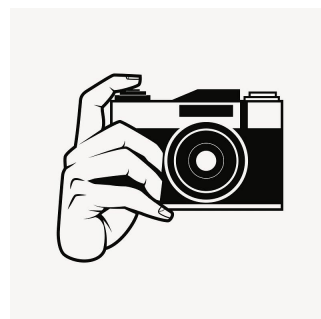


Messy Church is a family time for having fun. For being creative, for exploring faith and for enjoying a meal together.
