They learnt how to use stencils to create their own Gingerbread Man outlines to decorate. The Buttercups have been exploring the story of The Gingerbread Man this week.








And they worked really hard to carefully trace the outlines of some different gingerbread men too!

Always speak to the class teacher first. They know your child best and will be able to offer advice. You can message them through Class dojo or catch them on the playground at the end of the day.

The class teacher may complete an internal referral form which will be passed to Mrs Elsender (SENDCo) or Miss Evans (Pastoral Lead)

In school support is offered - this can include adjustments in the classroom, provision of sensory resources, intervention work or sessions with a learning mentor. If more support is needed a referral can be made to external agencies e.g. 0-19 Team, ADHD Foundation, Speech & Language, CAMHS, Bereavement UK.
