## October Spooky Half-Term Week



At Tam O'Shanter Urban Farm

This October, our Half-Term Activity Club will take on a Spooky Theme in the run-up to Hallowe'en!

### What happens during the session?

During the three-hour session the children will have the opportunity to make witches' brooms using twigs, they will create swirling magic potions and slimy, glow-in-the-dark ectoplasm. They will finish up with a spooky scavenger hunt around the farm. The sessions are run by qualified staff with DBS clearance.

### Do the sessions run all week?

The sessions run from Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> to Friday 27<sup>th</sup> October. Each session is a repeat, so just choose the time that suits you best. Spaces are limited however, so early booking is advised.

### Who can take part?

The sessions are pitched at children aged 8-13 years. Parent/Carers do not need to attend but they will need to leave emergency contact details.

### When and Where?

Each session will last three hours and will take place at the Farm. We will meet outside the Eco Building. We will need to make a prompt start in order to maximise our time together.

The Morning Session will run from 9am to 12pm.

The Afternoon Session will run from 12.30pm to 3.30pm

\*There is the option to book a packed lunch from the café from 12.00-12.30. This costs £5.00 but is offered free to children who can show that they are eligible for Free School Meals.

### Is there a cost?

Each session costs £10 per child and will include potion bottles, slime tubs and brooms to take home.

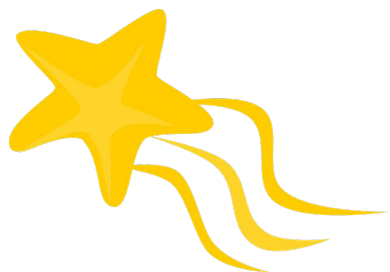
