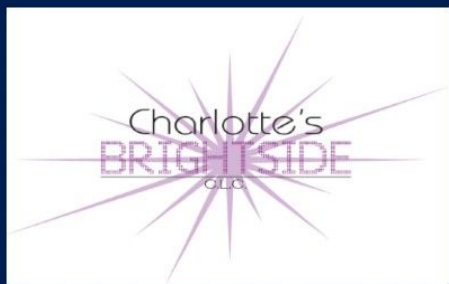
# NBVFC CHRISTMAS PRESENT APPEAL 2023
