### You will need

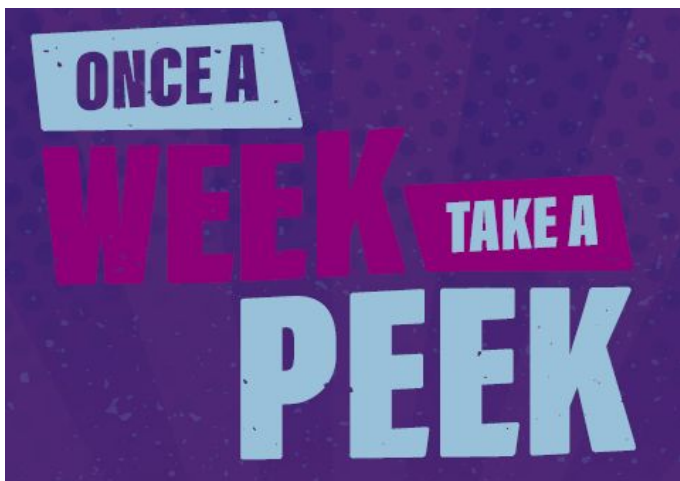
- A bag of skittles
