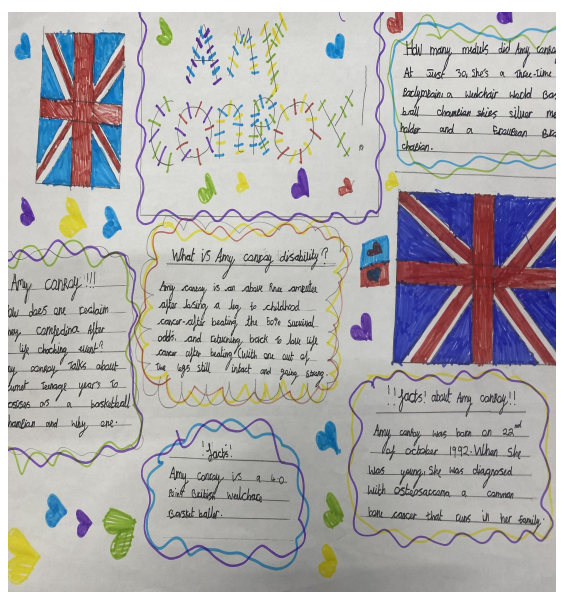
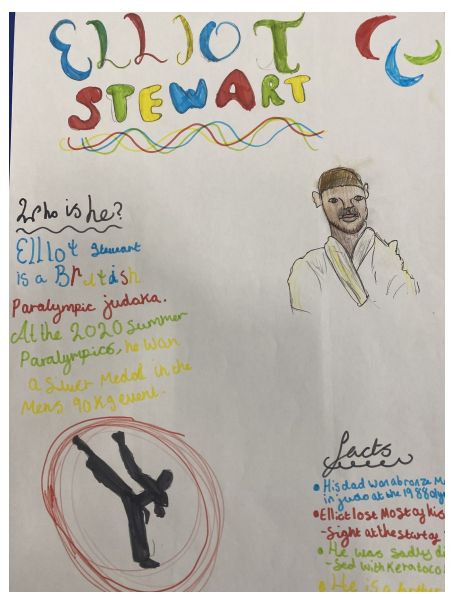
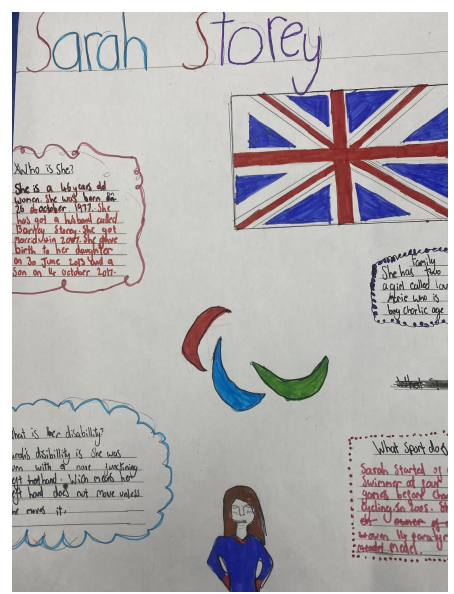




Friday 8th December

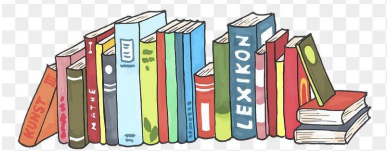

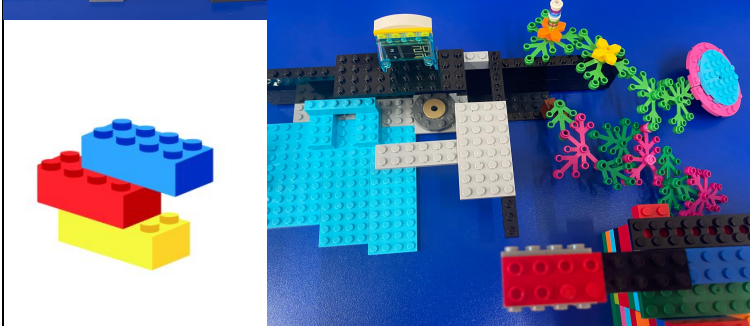
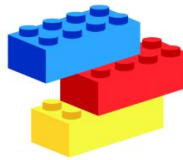

Nut Free School and Healthy Snacks

Please remember that we are a nut free school. We have a number of children and staff with allergies and in order to safeguard them we would ask that children do not come into school with snacks/lunches that contain nuts e.g. nutella, kinder bueno.

Children are welcome to bring healthy snacks for break times e.g. fruit, cereal bars, vegetables. Sweets and/or chocolate bars should not be brought to school for snacks or breakfast.



Parking



Can we remind parents that the zig zag lines outside school are not for parking. This includes pulling up on them to let children out. They are here to protect the children in a very busy and potentially dangerous time. Can you also be mindful of people with wheelchairs and/or pushchairs when parking on the pavements around school.

Playground Equipment

Remember that **school starts at 8:50am** and any time after this is late. Formal lessons start at 9:05 and the children need to be in, registered and settled for this time.

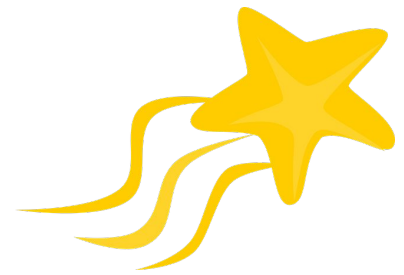
