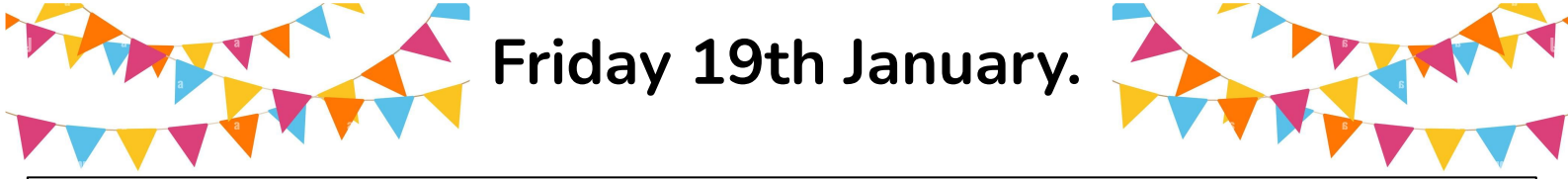

Last week Pearl from 2FP took part in Aladdin at the Floral Pavillion. 🏮



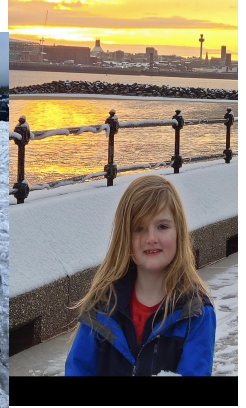

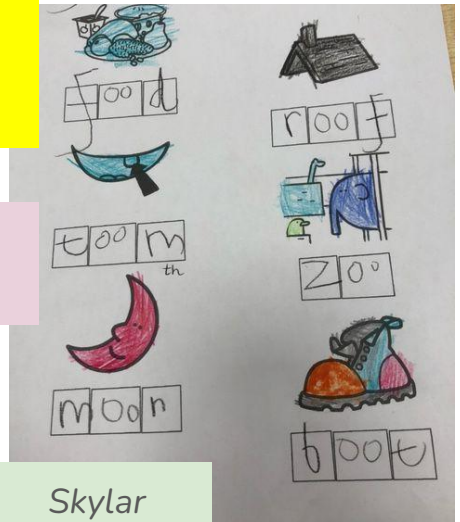
