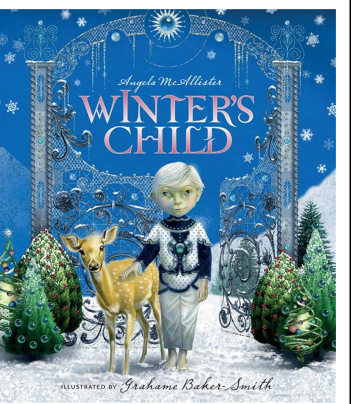


Year 5 have been working hard using tints, tones and shades to paint landscapes. 5DC produced some amazing pieces.

Hot Chocolate with the Head

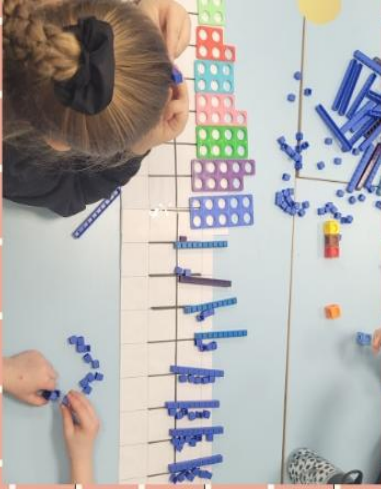

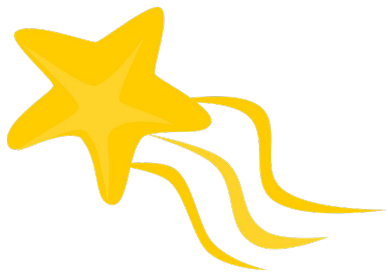
