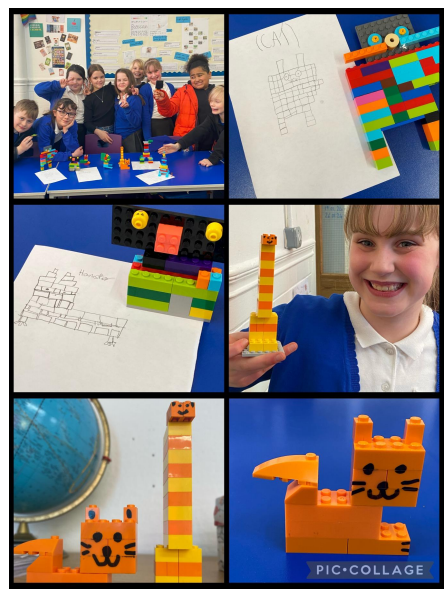

This week in Lego club, we have been designing animals to build from Lego. Check out our creations! We made cats, giraffes, a hamster, a beetle and even a blue penguin!



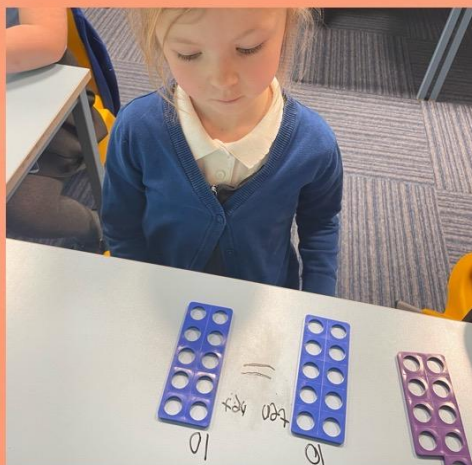
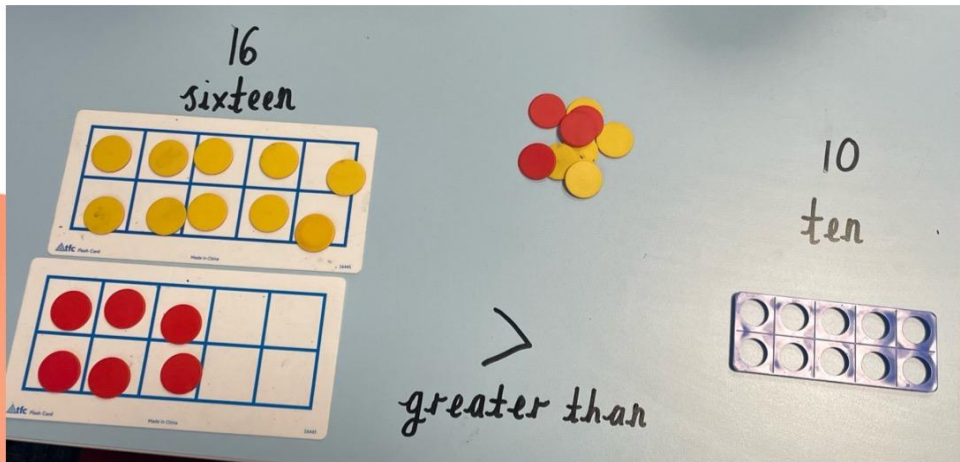
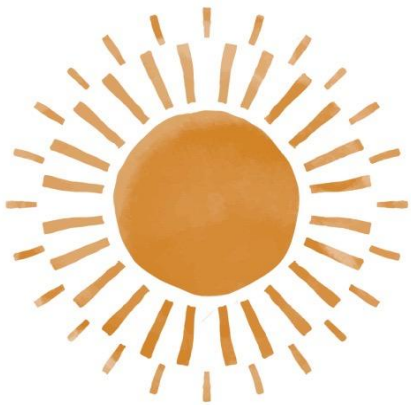
4CH are geo-tastic geographers:
