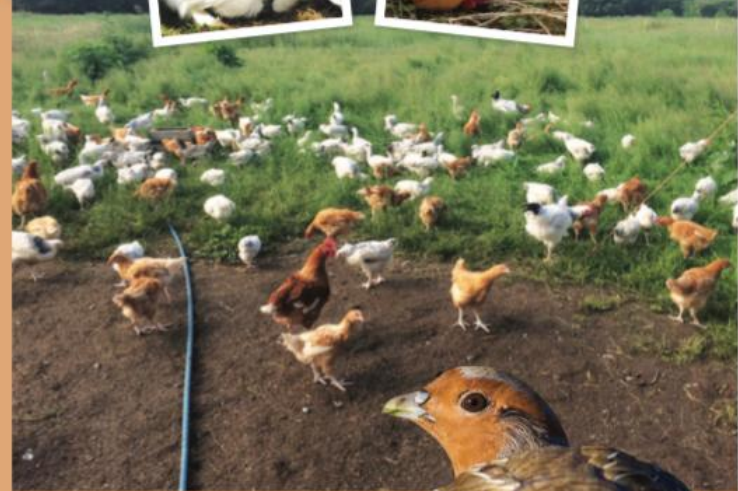
Preservation and welfare

Safeguarding the biodiversity of heritage breeds and promoting non-intensive, high-welfare farming practices

Working alongside specialist breeders, farmers and land-owners, **Incredible Eggs** are increasing the numbers

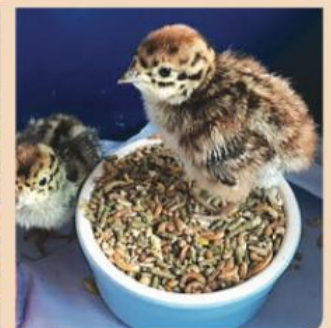
of grey partridges in the wild. This once common native bird is now on the Birds of Conservation Concern 'red list'. Red is the highest conservation priority, with species needing urgent action.



Schools, nurseries and care homes who book with **Incredible Eggs** are actively supporting the preservation of pure and rare poultry breeds, some of which are listed as 'at risk' with the Rare Breeds Survival Trust.
