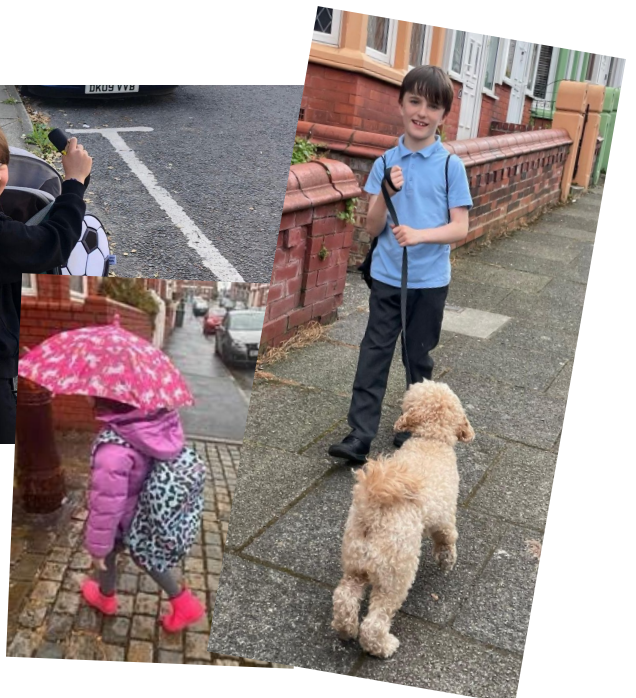
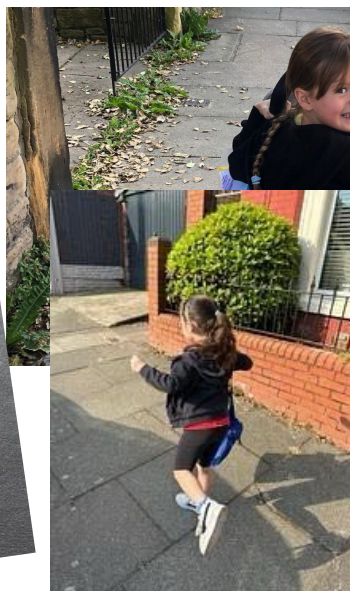

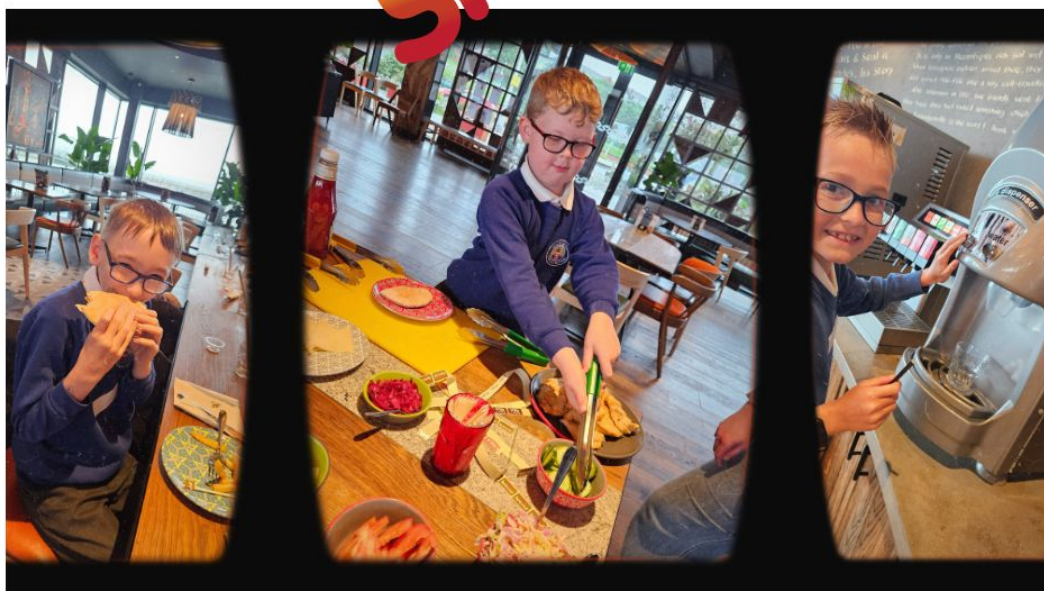


We had a fabulous trip to Nando's New Brighton this week.
