Help them understand the possible risks and benefits of going online with resources for parents, carers and teachers to use at home and in the classroom.

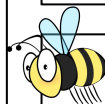

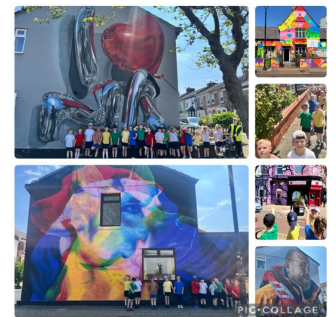

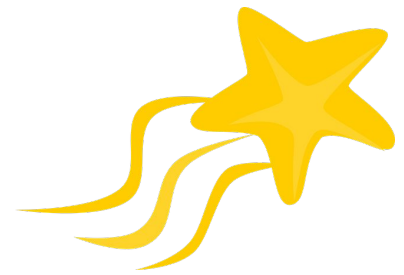
