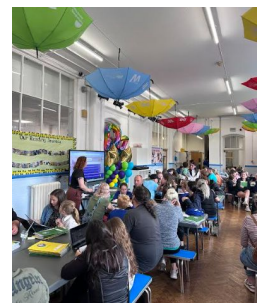


Welcome to Mrs Keeshan who has joined us as a teaching assistant in Yr5 and Yr6. A great addition to the team!

You have listened and watched and worked on your skills; you've achieved so much – we couldn't be more thrilled.

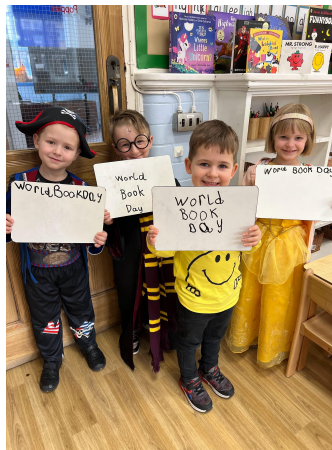
And though we know that you must move on, we'll be sad to lose you to the teachers in Year 1.
