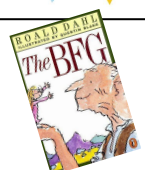
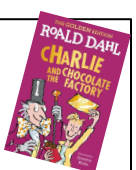

**Roald Dahl Day!**



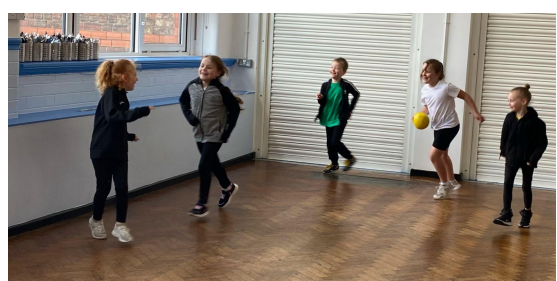
This year, we have celebrated Roald Dahl day by sharing our favourite poems and stories across school.

# Free School Meals.

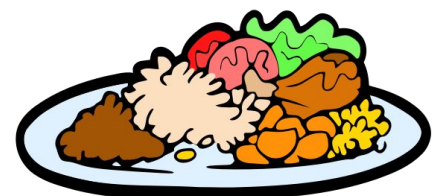
