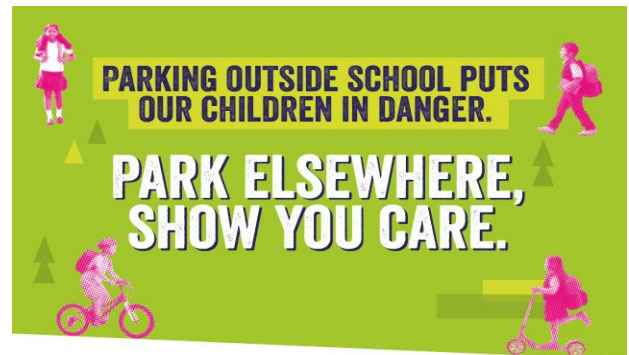
Christmas JUMPER DAY

On this day, the deli bar will be closed.

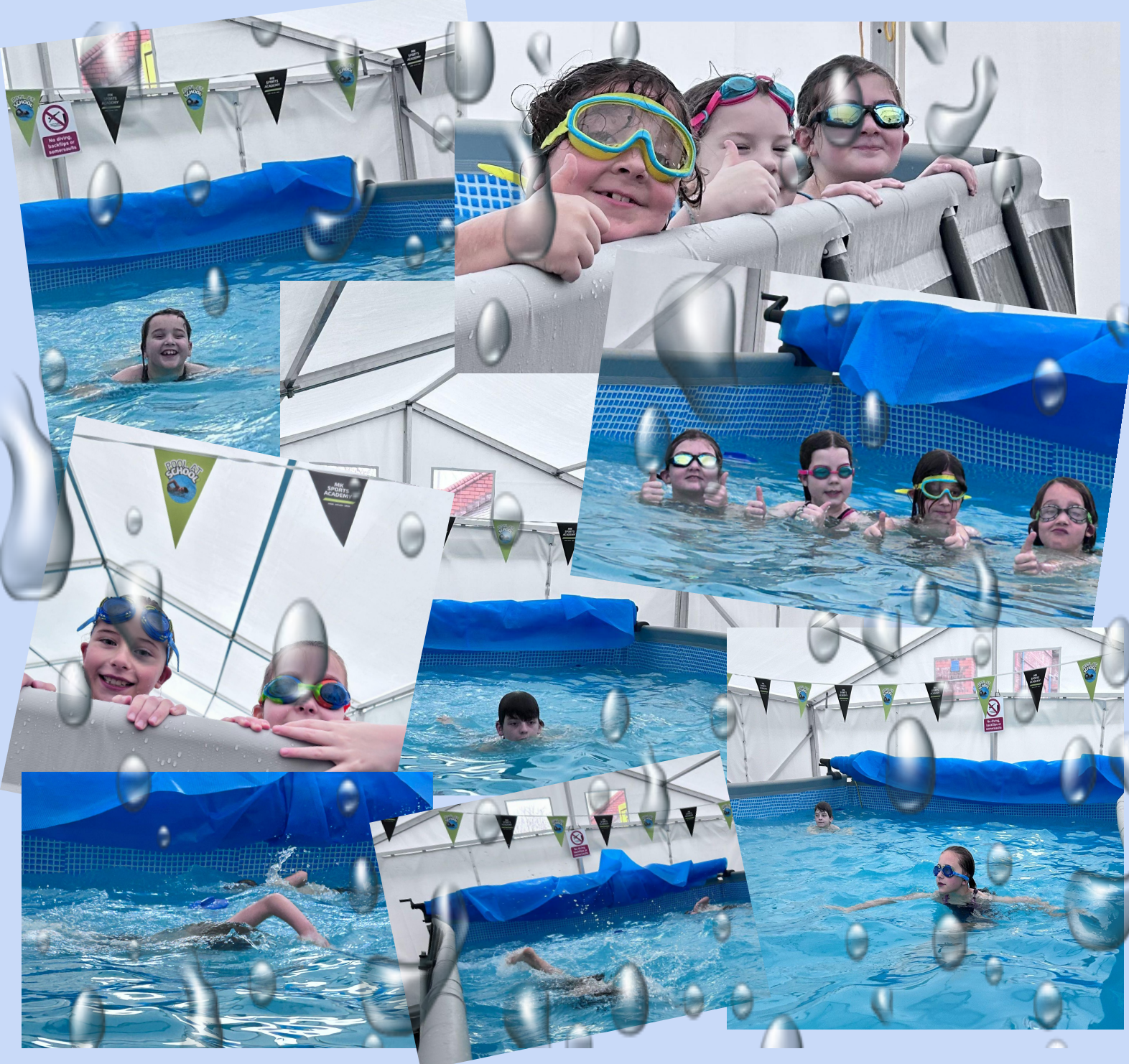


Last night's first annual Festive Family BINGO Night was a great success!
