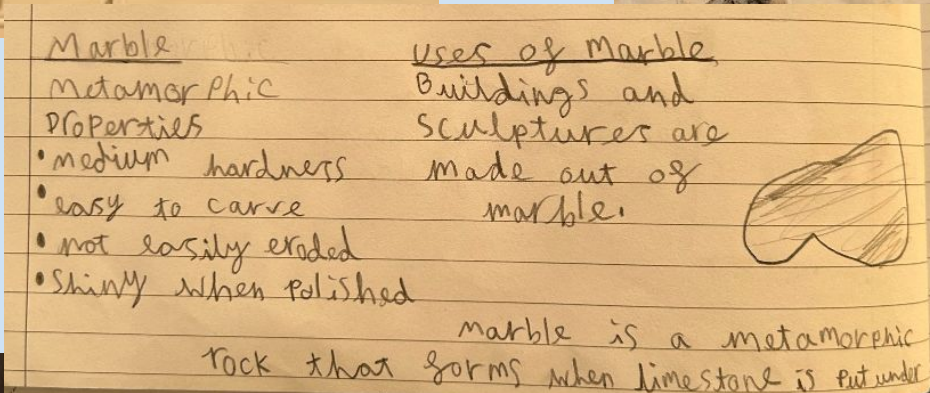
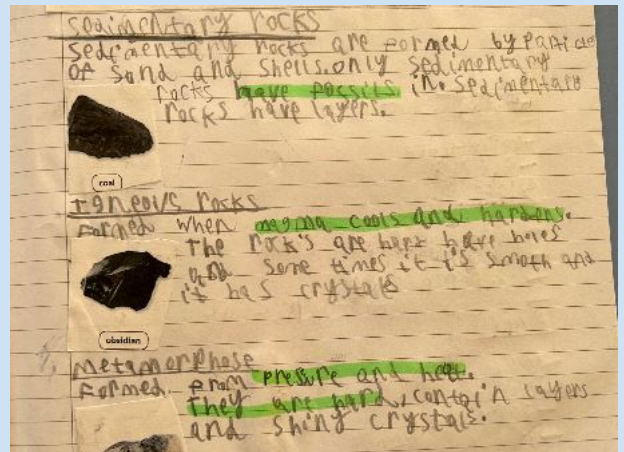
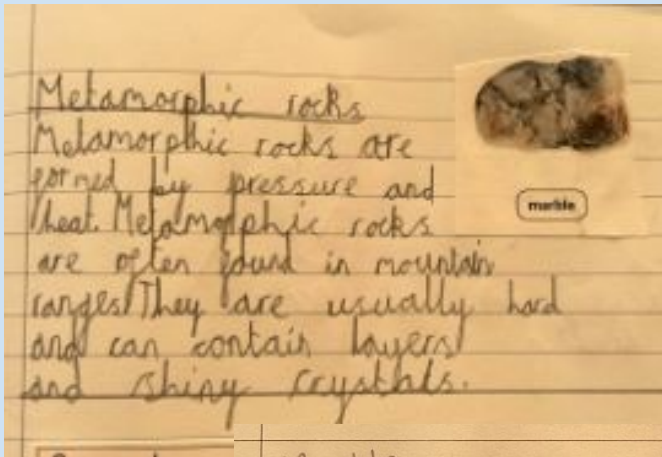


In 3LC this week...

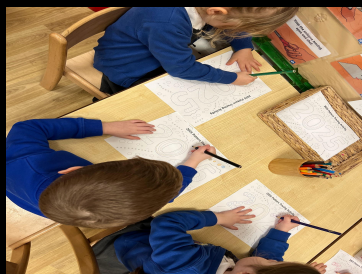


Happy New Year from the Sweetpeas

This week in Sweetpeas we have been thinking about the start of the new year.



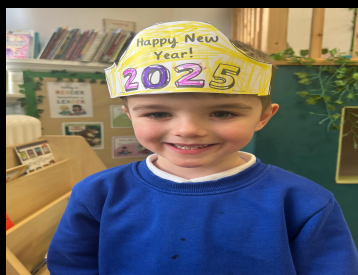
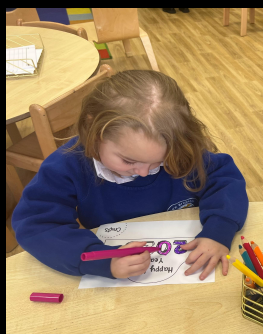
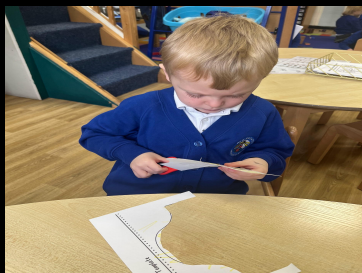
We held a New Year's Eve party in our role play area.



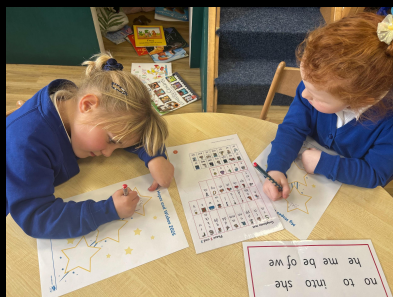
We practised our pencil control on patterns inside the numbers that made 2025.

Remember that school starts at 8:50am and any time after this is late. Formal lessons start at 9:05 and the children need to be in, registered and settled for this time.

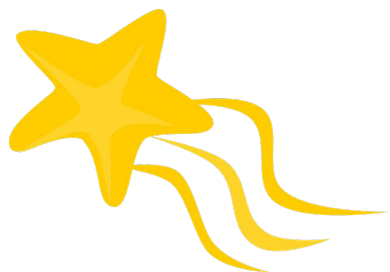
