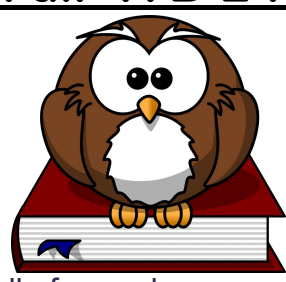
Y4 went on an exciting journey to North Wales as part of their Rivers and Mountains topic.
